## Foxfarms Hunter Derby

Open to horses that are entered in at least two classes at this show. Trainers may not ride in the 2'9 section and may only ride one horse in the 3' section and one horse in the 3'3 sections. Horses may only be shown in the height section that corresponds to the division they are being show in at this horse show, and may only show in one section. Horses that are showing in the 3'6 division may only enter the 3'3 section and horses showing in the 2'6 division may enter the 2'9 section. The Derby will be two rounds, judged over three different heights (2'9, 3' and 3'3). The first round to be shown over a course of at least 10 jumps and will include a bending line, two stride in & out, a long approach, natural jumps, a trot jump and an option fence. Riders will be placed 1st – 8th in each height section with prize money paid to 8th. The top twelve scores will come back for the second round and will jump at their respective heights. Riders scores from the first round will be averaged with the second round score to determine the overall winner. Prize money paid to 8th and ribbons to 12th.

## \$15,000 Foxfarms Hunter Derby Finals

Horses placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd in the first round, qualify for the Finals. The Derby Finals will be two rounds, judged over three different heights (2'9, 3' and 3'3). The first round to be shown over a course of at least 10 jumps and will include a bending line, two stride in & out, a long approach, natural jumps, a trot jump and an option fence. Riders will be placed 1st – 8th in each height with prize money paid to 8th. The top twelve scores will come back for the second round and will jump at their respective heights. Riders scores from the first round will be averaged with the second round score to determine the overall winner. Prize money paid to 8th and ribbons to 12th.

## CWD Equitation Derby

Requirements to qualify for the CWD Equitation Derby Finals include the following:

Compete in the CWD Equitation Divisions at the following shows; Northern Winter Classic III & IV, Murieta Spring Classic, Capital City Spring Classic, The Spectacular, Murieta Summer Classic, Let's Show Beach Party, Almaden Farms Summer, Almaden Farms Too, Let's Show Fall Festival, Let's Show Halloween Championship.

Be one of the top 6 riders on the "Show Championship Chart" for your division and earn points as follows: Champion 10 points, Reserve Champion 6 points, Third 4 points, Fourth 2 points, Fifth 1 point, Sixth ½ point.

## CWD Equitation Derby Finals

Riders who have earned 15 points from the CWD Equitation Division Champions, will be invited to participate in the finals to be held at the Murieta Autumn Classic. # JUMPER DIVISION

**Jumpers:** In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP111.2. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Riders are not required to wear Hunt Coats. Sweaters or Shirts with a collar only will be acceptable. Hunt Coats are required in Classics, Stake & Special Classes. Trophy to 1st, Ribbons 1-8; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-25%, 3rd-20%, 4th-15%, 5th-10%. Classes with less than 3 no prize money or Division Championship awarded. See rule 35 for additional Featured Jumper information. Class 1 – Pays 1st-8th.

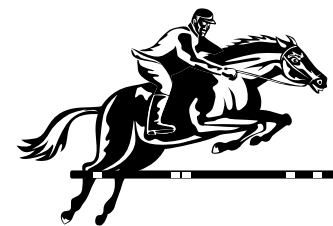

Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division, and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding Classes.
- FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR1502.5.
- The competition and its management agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the PCHA, its directors, officer, committee members, agents and employees from and against all loss or damage including any and all claims arising out of the competition, including claims as to personal injury or property loss or damage suffered during or in conjunction with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts or omissions of said directors, officers, committee members, agents or employees.
- MANAGEMENT:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the horse show management; its decision to be final.
- RESPONSIBILITY:** The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants and in compliance with all Federation rules.
- CONDITION OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the individual horse shows and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities, Federation, the Competition, FoxFarms Inc, Murietta Equestrian Center and Cosumnes Corp., and its employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show and the facilities at which each horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
- STALL REQUEST:** Trainers will be responsible for payment of all stalls requested. An open check is required to hold stalls. A \$30 late charge will be assessed on all entry blanks postmarked after the close of entries.
- ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Incomplete entry blanks may be returned. Entry blanks must be postmarked on or before the closing date of entries. Any entry postmarked after the closing date of entries will be charged a \$30 late fee. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for the applicable nominating fee and stall fee must be included. All horse on the grounds must have an entry blank, even non-showing horses. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries. Entries should not be made from the Schedule - consult the index of classes.
- NOMINATING FEE & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY:** Any entry postmarked after the close of entries is considered a post entry. Add/Scratches must be done on an Add/Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the horse show office. The nominating fee will follow:  
**Adding Classes** - no post entry fee if classes added the day before by 3:00pm after 3:00pm will incur a \$10 per class posted entry fee. Same day adds, if allowed, will incur a \$10 per post entry fee and a \$50 post entry fee for Featured Classes.  
**Scratching Classes** - classes scratched the day before receive full refund. Same day scratches receive a full refund, but will incur a \$10 per class same day scratch fee. Featured Classes scratching the same day no refund.
- ENTRY BLANKS:** Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper division or class. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in making out entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.  
 A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian.  
 B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.  
 C. Show the correct mailing address of the owner.  
 D. Social Security number must be included on entry blank.  
 E. Include copy of USEF membership card or pay \$30 non-member fee for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer and rider.  
 F. Include copy of USHJA membership card or pay \$30 non-member fee for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer and rider.  
 G. Include PCHA membership numbers or pay a \$10 non-member fee for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer and rider.  
 H. Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of junior and amateur riders. Please attach photocopy of USEF amateur card.  
 I. Please attach photocopy of USEF pony measurement card for any ponies entered in the Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters & Pony Jumpers division.  
 K. Please attach photocopy of USEF measurement card for any junior hunter entered in the junior hunter division.
- REFUND POLICY:** All refund request must be submitted in writing. Refunds will be issued within 4 weeks of the close of the show.  
 A. Before close of entries all fees will be refunded.  
 B. After the closing date of entries, no refunds will be given unless you meet one of the following requirements.  
  - Prior to start of show, entry fees will be refunded less the stall fee and nominating fee.
  - After the show starts, classes that are scratched in the Horse Show Office the day before the class is scheduled will be refunded.
  - After the horse's number is picked up, classes that are scratched

- in the Horse Show Office the day of the class will not be refunded.
- Post entry fees will not be credited or refunded.
  - After the show starts, if a competitor is ill or injured and cannot compete in the balance of the classes, that competitor will be entitled to a refund of unused class fees provided the classes are officially scratched within 48 hours and a doctor's certificate is provided to the Horse Show Office. Stall and nominating fees are not refunded.
  - After the show starts, if a horse is ill or injured classes scratched the same day they are scheduled receive a full refund with an Official Show Veterinarian Certificate provided the Horse Show Office receives it with 48 hours.
  - No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show.
12. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. \$25 OR 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK!! Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
13. **UNPAID CHARGES:** If the show management or show official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill an exhibitor for unpaid charges, a \$25 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
14. **PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money not deducted from the statement will be made payable to the owner listed on the entry blank and mailed within thirty days after the show. PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. ANYONE REQUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$100 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE. PRIZE MONEY CHECKS NOT CASHED AFTER 90 DAYS WILL HAVE A STOP PAYMENT PLACED ON THEM AND THE EXHIBITOR WILL FORFEIT THE PRIZE MONEY. PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Foreign exhibitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8 prior to the Murieta Spring Classic Horse Shows issuing prize money won.
15. **ADD-BACK:** In classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.
16. **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:**

 Departure by 7:00 PM Sunday, March 23, 2014
17. **PARKING:** Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
18. **RV's:** RV parking must be booked through the MEC office (916) 985-7334.
19. **GOLF CART, BICYCLES, ETC.:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
20. **STABLING:** Stalls, whether occupied by horses, feed or tack will

- be available for \$140 each. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given, if there is a shortage of stalls. **NO STRAW ALLOWED. Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors 10 x 10**
21. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show office (916) 985-7334.
22. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management.
23. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each competitor which shall be worn on the rider's back clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
24. **COURSES:** Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
25. **POLING:** Not allowed in California.
26. **HARD HATS AND ATTIRE:** USEF GR801. It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
26. **HARD HATS AND ATTIRE:** USEF GR801. will be strictly enforced. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR is mandatory while jumping at all times. All exhibitors are required to wear shoes or boots with a riding heel whenever mounted on horseback on the grounds.
27. **DOGS:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. See USEF GR301.6 Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a fine of \$25. A second offense may cause the owner to be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds. Refusal to pay the fine will bar the owner from further participation in the horse show and the owner will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
28. **MEASURING OF ENTRIES:** Time of measuring will be posted in the Horse Show Office. ALL HUNTER AND JUMPER PONIES AND JUNIOR HUNTERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF OR THEIR ORIGINAL MEASUREMENT CARDS PRESENTED TO ONE OF THE SHOW SECRETARIES OR BE MEASURED IF THE CARD IS NOT AVAILABLE, BEFORE THE EXHIBITORS' NUMBER WILL BE RELEASED.
29. **TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER:** Each day at 3:00 PM the time schedule for the next day's schedule will be available. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. The trainer, exhibitor or other representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so that arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider as well as the time schedule. All management decisions will be final Order of go will be drawn according to USEF Rule JP111.2.
30. **SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that paddock stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
31. **ARENAS:** All show and warm-up arenas consist of sand footing.

**Hunter 2** - 105' X 240'

32. **GROUNDS FEE:** Per day per horse not using a stall - \$30.00
33. **NON SHOWING POLICY:** Non-Showing horses are allowed on space available basis only. For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a "Not to Show Form" and sign a release at the Horse Show Office, and pay a \$25 facility fee plus a \$25 schooling fee and stall fees, if applicable.
34. **2014 ZONE 10 SPECIFICATIONS:** Please see USHJA.org for current class specification with regards to; Children's Hunters, Adult Amateur Hunters, Pre-Green Hunter, Low Children's Jumpers, Low Adult Amateur Jumpers, Children's Jumpers, Adult Amateur Jumpers, Classics, Pony Jumper Championship & Junior Jumpers.
35. **FEATURED JUMPER & HUNTER CLASSES:** Horses must be entered the day before the scheduled class. Horses entering the

- same day may be required to go first and will pay the entry fee and a \$50 post entry fee. No refund will be given for same day scratches. Featured classes with fewer than 15 horses; prize money and entry fee will be split in half. Featured classes with less than 8 horses may ride for ribbons and an entry fee of \$50.

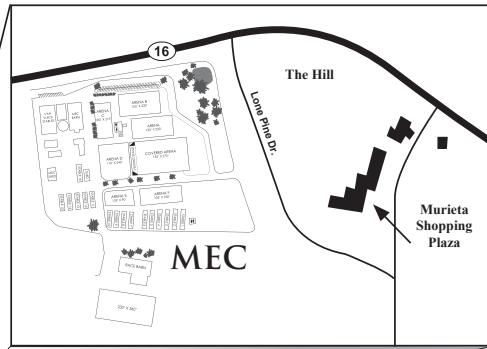
