About



Since opening its gates in 1982, the Murieta Equestrian Center (MEC) has been one of the largest privately-owned equestrian and event facilities in California. MEC is located 24 miles east of downtown Sacramento in the community of Rancho Murieta.



This versatile facility features:

- ≈ Four indoor arenas ideal for year round events
- ≈ World class cutting arena
- ≈ 13 outdoor arenas with high performance footing
- ≈ Main indoor arena with seating for 2,500 spectators
- ≈ 100+ RV spaces
- ≈ Acres of grassy park-like settings for large events

Our facility hosts approximately 50 events annually, with over 180,000 competitors and spectators. Whether you are planning an equestrian competition, a festival, concert, demonstration, wedding, horse clinic, or sports competition, we can accommodate events of all shapes and sizes. We have the amenities to help make your event a success.



Purpose

To create an environment worthy of the efforts of our participants and to provide a prime destination for equestrian sports.

1982

The Anderson family purchased the Murieta Equestrian Center more than 30 years ago and began the development that would turn it into a premier horse show facility. Today, MEC is a popular destination enjoyed by equestrians, sports enthusiasts and community members year-round.



2007-CURRENT

A partnership between the Murieta Equestrian center and the West Coast Equine Foundation was created as a way for Carol Anderson Ward and MEC management to give back to the horse community.

The Future

There is a lot of excitement building in Rancho Murieta and at the Murieta Equestrian Center!

~ The Murieta Inn & Spa:

This Spanish-style Inn & Spa will offer 83 spacious rooms and a steakhouse restaurant, all in a beautifully landscaped setting.

~ Shopping:

A shopping center (about a 1/4 mile down the road from MEC) will also break ground in the near future. The center's retail stores and restaurants will add convenience during shows and events.

At the Murieta Equestrian Center:

~ Arena Expansion:

MEC is continually planning for additional arenas, while updating current arenas. MEC currently has a total of 19 arenas.

~ New concessions/offices:

A new concession area featuring an indoor and outdoor dining/food and beverage facility, and a new office complex to house both horse show and the West Coast Equine Foundation offices (completion 2017).

~ New restroom facilities:

Brand new restroom facilities are conveniently located in the heart of the equestrian center.






Main Indoor Arena (Arena 1)

Located in the heart of the equestrian center, the Main Indoor Arena (arena 1) is for equestrian and large scale events. The arena offers a 30,855-sq. ft. (121 ft. x 255 ft.) competition/exhibition area, seating for 3,000 spectators, broadcast quality lighting, a quality sound system, nearby parking, restrooms, concession areas, and ADA accessibility. The Cares & Whoas retail store is also located in the main indoor arena.

- Seating for up to 3,000
- Excellent views from all seats
- Water & electricity throughout
- Permanent restroom facilities
- ADA accessibility
- VIP deck seating areas
- Vendor areas just outside the arena
- Large ceiling fans for air circulation
- Stadium rental includes horse show office
- Accommodates year-round events

Arena 3

Arena 3 is a covered arena used for a variety of horse shows and equestrian events. The arena features a 23,500-sq. ft. (100 ft. x 235 ft.) competition/exhibition area, seating for 500 spectators, quality lighting, sound system, restrooms, concession areas, and ADA accessibility.

Features:

- Arena enclosed by metal and wood fencing
- Arena rental includes production offices based on availability
- Accommodates year-round events
- Livestock handling capabilities

Stable Mix Arena (4) & Finish Line Arena (7)

These arenas feature 105 ft. x 240 ft. (Arena 4) and 105 ft. x 250 ft. (Arena 7) for competitions and exhibitions. These covered arenas can also be used for a broad range of year-round horse shows and events. They are both enclosed with metal fencing and gates.

- On-site feed and bedding sales




