GREEN AS GRASS RIDERS MAY USE TWO HANDS WITH ANY LEGAL BIT, AND MAY RIDE A HORSE OWNED BY SOMEONE ELSE (INCLUDING NON-FAMILY MEMBERS).

NOVICE HORSE LEVEL 2 (OPEN AND NON PRO)

- RESTRICTED TO HORSES THAT HAVE NOT EARNED MORE THAN \$25,000 IN NRHA LIFETIME EARNINGS. NON PRO RESTRICTED TO RIDERS WITH A VALID NRHA NON PRO CARD AND RULES OF OWNERSHIP AS STATED IN THE NON PRO CONDITIONS.

ROOKIE LEVEL 2 – OPEN TO ANY RIDER HOLDING A VALID NRHA NON PRO CARD WHO HAS EARNED LESS THAN \$1500 IN NRHA LIFETIME EARNINGS OR 300 YOUTH POINTS (EXCLUDING POINTS EARNED IN THE YOUTH 10 & UNDER SHORT STIRRUP CLASS). RIDERS MAY USE A HORSE WITHOUT THE RESTRICTIONS OF OWNER-SHIP FOR NON PRO CLASSES AS DEFINED UNDER NON PRO CONDITIONS. **OPEN:** OPEN TO ALL RIDERS AND HORSES REGARDLESS OF AGE.

ROOKIE YOUTH: OPEN TO ANY YOUTH RIDER WHO HAS NOT EARNED MORE THAN 25 PTS IN NRHA YOUTH CLASSES AT THE START OF THE YEAR.

LIMITED NON PRO: NON PRO RIDER THAT HAS EARNED LESS THAN \$10,000 IN NRHA LIFETIME EARN-INGS.

MONEY EARNINGS: BASED ON MONEY EARNED IN REINING AT ANY BREED, COLOR, USA EQUESTRIAN OR AF LIATE, LOCAL, REGIONAL, NATIONAL, SCHOOLING, JACKPOT, OR ADDED SHOW. *PLEASE CHECK NRHA 2018 HANDBOOK ON BY-LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS JUDGES GUIDE.

SCHOOLING REINING: SPACES LIMITED TO THE FIRST HORSES PAID IN FULL. ENTER AS CLASS 1A. SLOTS WILL BE RUN **MARCH 28.** EACH SLOT CONSISTS OF SIX MINUTES TOTAL (TWO MINUTES TO ENTER AND EXIT, FOUR MINUTES TO RUN). \$30 PER RUN.

WESTERN DEFINITIONS



Youth/Western Classes: An individual who has not reached his/her 19th Birthday as of January 1st of the current year. The age of the youth as of January 1st will be the age maintained the entire year to enter.

AMATEUR/WESTERN CLASSES: AN EXHIBITOR 19 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO IS AN AMATEUR DE NED BY THE UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION(USEF) OR RECOGNIZED BREED ORGANIZATION. A CURRENT USEF OR BREED ORGANIZATION AMATEUR CARD IS ADVISED. FOR REINING CLASSES, EITHER A WCRHA OR NRHA NON PRO CARD IS ACCEPTABLE.

1ST & 2ND YEAR GREEN PLEASURE: A HORSE IN ITS FIRST OR SECOND YEAR OF SHOWING IN WESTERN PLEASURE.

AQHA GREEN WESTERN PLEASURE: A HORSE IN IT'S FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING WESTERN PLEASURE OR, HAS NOT YET WON 10 POINTS IN WESTERN PLEASURE.

1ST & 2ND YEAR GREEN TRAIL: A FIRST AND SECOND YEAR GREEN TRAIL HORSE IS A HORSE THAT HAS NOT SHOWN 2 YEARS OF TRAIL.

AQHA GREEN TRAIL: A HORSE IN ITS FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING TRAIL OR THAT HASN'T WON 10 AQHA TRAIL POINTS.


LIMIT: A LIMIT AMATEUR OR LIMIT YOUTH IS AN AMATEUR OR YOUTH WHO HAS NOT WON 6 BLUE RIBBONS IN THE CLASS IN WHICH THEY ARE SHOWING, AT ANY BREED OR "A" RATED SHOWS, INCLUDING PREVI-OUS MEC GOLD-N-GRAND HORSE SHOWS. **MUST PROVIDE LIFE LONG EXHIBITOR SHOW RECORD INCLUDED WITH ENTRY TO ENTER LIMIT CLASSES. IF EXHIBITOR IS FOUND INELIGABLE, ALL AWARDS SHALL BE FORFEITED AND SHALL BE RETURNED IMMEDIATLY, OR, IF POST-SHOW, WITHIN SEVEN DAYS*** **AMATEUR SELECT 45 & OVER:** AN EXHIBITOR 45 & OVER OF AGE OR OLDER WHO IS AN AMATEUR DEFINED BY THE USEF OR RECOGNIZED BREED ORGANIZATION.

FREESTYLE LEADLINE: FREESTYLE SHALL CONSIST OF CHILDREN 3 - 6. **THURSDAY AND SATURDAY'S** CLASS WILL PROCEED IN STANDARD LEADLINE PRESENTATIONS. **FRIDAY** WILL BE A SPECIAL PRESENTATION MADE BY EACH LEADLINE TEAM SEE DESCRIPTION: LIMITED TO ONE HANDLER, THEY WILL BE ALLOWED 5 MINUTES MAXIMUM TO SET UP THEIR PROPS AND COMPLETE THEIR EXHIBI-TION. THEY MAY USE MUSIC AND PROPS, IT IS LIMITED TO WALKING AND JOGGING ONLY, AND THE HANDLER MUST ALWAYS HAVE AHOLD OF HORSE! MUSIC MUST BE GIVEN TO SHOW STAFF BEFORE THE SHOW STARTS AND THEY WILL NEED TO LET GNG STAFF KNOW IF THE NEED HELP WITH ANY PROPS. PRIZES WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL BUT THE CLASS WILL BE PLACED. CHILD MUST BE ABLE TO STAY IN THE SADDLE UNASSISTED SAFELY WHILE BEING

LED BY AN ADULT. ****HELMET REQUIRED****

SHOWMANSHIP: ONLY THE EXHIBITOR IS TO BE JUDGED; THE HORSE IS MERELY A PROP TO SHOW THE ABILITY OF THE HANDLER. THE CLASS IS JUDGED STRICT-LY ON THE CONTESTANT'S ABILITY TO FIT AND SHOW IN A HALTER CLASS. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED A MINIMUM OF ONE HOUR OR MORE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.

WESTERN DEFINITIONS


WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP: RIDERS TO BE JUDGED ON SEAT, HANDS, AND ABILITY TO CONTROL AND SHOW THE HORSE. RESULTS AS SHOWN BY PERFORMANCE OF THE HORSE ARE NOT TO BE CONSIDERED MORE IMPORT-ANT THAN THE METHOD USED BY THE RIDER. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED A MINIMUM OF ONE HOUR OR MORE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.

WESTERN PLEASURE: TO BE SHOWN AT A WALK, JOG, AND LOPE BOTH WAYS OF THE RING ON A REASONABLY LOOSE REIN OR LIGHT CONTACT WITHOUT UNDUE RESTRAINT. TO BE JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, CONDI-TION, AND CONFORMATION OF THE HORSE.

TRAIL: TO BE SHOWN OVER AND THROUGH OBSTACLES AT WALK, JOG, AND LOPE ON A REASONABLY LOOSE REIN WITHOUT UNDUE RESTRAINT. TO BE JUDGED ON THE PERFORMANCE OF THE HORSE OVER OBSTACLES WITH EMPHASIS ON MANNERS, RESPONSE TO THE RIDER, AND ATTITUDE. SCHOOLING TRAIL WILL OPEN **AUGUST 3** AT **10AM.** TRAIL ARENA WILL BE OPEN EACH EVENING AFTER THE TRAIL COURSE HAS BEEN SET; UNTIL ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE START EACH DAY (START TIME WILL BE ON THE SCHEUDLE). EACH HORSE ENTERED IN A TRAIL CLASS WILL BE CHARGED \$30 FOR SCHOOING TRAIL. AQHA CLASSES WILL BE RUN WITH CORRESPONDING GNG CLASS(ONLY ONE ROUND). TRAIL CLASSES WILL BE RUN IN BLOCKS. PLEASE CHECK TRAIL SCHEDULE DAILY.

10 & UNDER WALK/JOG PLEASURE, EQUITATION, & TRAIL: Pleasure and equitation classes will walk and Jog both directions of the Arena. Trail classes will walk or Jog over obstacles. Riders may not cross enter into any other division where lope/canter is required. **RE-RIDE CLASS:** NOT TO HAVE SHOWN^VIN THE PAST 10 YEARS. MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS FOR ONE FULL YEAR.

1st timers class: Never to have shown a horse.



RANCH HORSE DEFINITIONS

RANCH RIDING FLAT: REFLECTS THE VERSATILITY, ATTITUDE AND MOVEMENT OF A WORKING HORSE. THE HORSE'S PERFORMANCE SHOULD SIMULATE A HORSE RIDING OUTSIDE THE CON NES OF AN ARENA AND THAT OF A WORKING RANCH HORSE. THIS CLASS SHOULD SHOW THE HORSE'S ABILITY TO WORK AT A FOWARD SPEED WHILE UNDER THE RIDER'S CONTROL. THIS CLASS WILL BE JUDGED AT THE WALK, TROT AND LOPE ON THE RAIL.

RANCH RIDING: REFLECTS THE VERSATILITY, ATTITUDE AND MOVEMENT OF A WORKING HORSE. THE HORSE'S PERFORMANCE SHOULD SIMULATE A HORSE RIDING OUTSIDE THE CON NES OF AN ARENA AND THAT OF A WORKING RANCH HORSE. THIS CLASS SHOULD SHOW THE HORSE'S ABILITY TO WORK AT A FOWARD SPEED WHILE UNDER THE RIDER'S CONTROL. THIS IS A PATTERN CLASS.

RANCH HORSE TRAIL: THIS CLASS WILL WORK A MINIUMUM OF SIX OBSTACLES DESIGNED TO SHOW A HORSES ABILITY AND WILLINGNESS TO PERFORM A NORMAL DAYS RANCH WORK. WILL INCLUDE A WALK, TROT AND LOPE AS PART OF THE TRAIL COURSE. SCORING WILL BE SIMILAR TO AQHA. ***NOTE** THERE WILL BE A LOG DRAG IN THE RANCH HORSE TRAIL OPEN CLASS. ***AMATEUR/ SELECT, THERE WILL BE A LONG DRAG IN THE RANCH HORSE TRAIL OPEN, AM, AM SELECT CLASSES. THE RANCH TRAIL CLASSES ARE GNG ONLY APPROVED. EXHIBITOR MIGHT BE ASKED TO ROPE A DUMMY AND ASKED TO MOUNT OR DISMOUNT. WILL BE USING AQHA VRH RULES AS A GUIDELINE. REFER TO AQHA RULEBOOK FOR DE NITIONS OF CLASS, EQUIPMENT, ETC.

**NEXTS DAYS PATTERN WILL NOT BE SET UNTIL EVENING BEFORE CLASS.

RANCH HORSE CONFORMATION: TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE RANCH CONFORMATION CLASS, THE HORSE MUST BE SHOWN IN AT LEAST ONE CLASS ONE OF THE OTHER CATEGORIES THE DAY OF THE SHOW. JUDGES ARE LOOKING FOR BALANCED, STRUC-TURALLY CORRECT HORSES WITH ADEQUATE MUSCLING. YOU'LL NEED TO SHOW YOUR HORSE IN A GOOD WORKING HALTER - ROPE, BRAIDED, NYLON OR PLAIN LEATHER - EXHIBIT YOUR HORSE AT A WALK AND A TROT, THEN LINE UP FOR INSPECTION BY THE JUDGE.
