



SCHOOLING REINING: SPACES LIMITED TO THE FIRST HORSES PAID IN FULL ENTER AS CLASS 1A. SLOTS WILL BE RUN **JULY 9, 2020.** EACH SLOT CONSISTS OF SIX MINUTES TOTAL (TWO MINUTES TO ENTER AND EXIT, FOUR MINUTES TO RUN). \$30 PER RUN.

WESTERN DEFINITIONS

Youth/Western Classes: An individual who has not reached his/her 19th Birthday as of January 1st of the current year. The age of the youth as of January 1st will be the age maintained the entire year to enter.

AQHA GREEN WESTERN PLEASURE: A HORSE IN IT'S FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING WESTERN PLEASURE OR, HAS NOT YET WON 10 POINTS IN WESTERN PLEASURE.

1ST & 2ND YEAR GREEN TRAIL: A FIRST AND SECOND YEAR GREEN TRAIL HORSE IS A HORSE THAT HAS NOT SHOWN 2 YEARS OF TRAIL.

AQHA GREEN TRAIL: A HORSE IN ITS FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING TRAIL OR THAT HASN'T WON 10 AQHA TRAIL POINTS.

AMATEUR SELECT 45 & OVER: AN EXHIBITOR 45 & OVER OF AGE OR OLDER WHO IS AN AMATEUR DEFINED BY THE USEF OR RECOGNIZED BREED ORGANIZATION.

LIMIT: A LIMIT AMATEUR OR LIMIT YOUTH IS AN AMATEUR OR YOUTH WHO HAS NOT WON 6 BLUE RIBBONS IN THE CLASS IN WHICH THEY ARE SHOWING, AT ANY BREED OR "A" RATED SHOWS, INCLUDING PREVIOUS MEC GOLD-N-GRAND HORSE SHOWS. **MUST PROVIDE LIFE LONG EXHIBITOR SHOW RECORD INCLUDED WITH ENTRY TO ENTER LIMIT CLASSES. IF EXHIBITOR IS FOUND IN-ELIGABLE, ALL AWARDS SHALL BE FORFEITED AND SHALL BE RETURNED IMMEDIATLY, OR, IF POST-SHOW, WITHIN SEVEN DAYS***

FREESTYLE LEADLINE: FREESTYLE SHALL CONSIST OF CHILDREN 3 - 6. FRIDAY AND SUNDAY'S CLASS WILL PROCEED IN STANDARD LEADLINE PRESENTATIONS. **SATURDAY** WILL BE A SPECIAL PRESENTATION MADE BY EACH LEADLINE TEAM SEE DESCRIPTION: LIMITED TO ONE HANDLER, THEY WILL BE ALLOWED **2** MINUTES MAXIMUM TO SET UP THEIR PROPS AND COMPLETE THEIR EXHIBITION. THEY MAY USE MUSIC AND PROPS, IT IS LIMITED TO WALKING AND JOGGING ONLY, AND THE HANDLER MUST ALWAYS HAVE AHOLD OF HORSE! MUSIC MUST BE GIVEN TO SHOW STAFF BEFORE THE SHOW STARTS AND THEY WILL NEED TO LET GNG STAFF KNOW IF THE NEED HELP WITH ANY PROPS. PRIZES WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL BUT THE CLASS WILL BE PLACED. CHILD MUST BE ABLE TO STAY IN THE SADDLE UNASSISTED SAFELY WHILE BEING LED BY AN ADULT. **HELMET REQUIRED***

WESTERN DEFINITIONS (CONTINUED)

SHOWMANSHIP: ONLY THE EXHIBITOR IS TO BE JUDGED; THE HORSE IS MERELY A PROP TO SHOW THE ABILITY OF THE HANDLER. THE CLASS IS JUDGED STRICTLY ON THE CONTESTANT'S ABILITY TO FIT AND SHOW IN A HALTER CLASS. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED A MINIMUM OF ONE HOUR OR MORE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP: RIDERS TO BE JUDGED ON SEAT, HANDS, AND ABILITY TO CONTROL AND SHOW THE HORSE. RESULTS AS SHOWN BY PERFORMANCE OF THE HORSE ARE NOT TO BE CONSIDERED MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE METHOD USED BY THE RIDER. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED A MINIMUM OF ONE HOUR OR MORE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.

WESTERN PLEASURE: TO BE SHOWN AT A WALK, JOG, AND LOPE BOTH WAYS OF THE RING ON A REASONABLY LOOSE REIN OR LIGHT CONTACT WITHOUT UNDUE RESTRAINT. TO BE JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, CONDITION, AND CONFORMATION OF THE HORSE.

OPEN TRAIL SADDLE CHAMPIONSHIP: OPEN TO ANY HORSE/RIDER COMBO. MUST BE AT LEAST 8 HORSES ENTERED TO HOLD THE CLASS.

HALTER: OPEN TO MARES, GELDINGS, STALLIONS, ALL AGES, ALL BREEDS. YOUTH MAY NOT SHOW STALLIONS.

TRAIL: TO BE SHOWN OVER AND THROUGH OBSTACLES AT WALK, JOG, AND LOPE ON A REASONABLY LOOSE REIN WITHOUT UNDUE restraint. To be judged on the performance of the horse OVER OBSTACLES WITH EMPHASIS ON MANNERS, RESPONSE TO THE RIDER, AND ATTITUDE. SCHOOLING TRAIL WILL OPEN JULY 11 AT **10AM.** TRAIL ARENA WILL BE OPEN EACH EVENING AFTER THE TRAIL COURSE HAS BEEN SET; UNTIL 6 AM FRIDAY, SATURDAY & SUNDAY. (START TIME WILL BE ON THE SCHEDULE). EACH HORSE ENTERED IN A TRAIL CLASS WILL BE CHARGED \$30 FOR SCHOOLING TRAIL. AQHA CLASSES WILL BE RUN WITH CORRESPONDING GNG CLASS(ONLY ONE ROUND). TRAIL CLASSES WILL BE RUN IN OPEN ARENA SIGN UP. TRAIL CLASSES WILL WALK OR JOG OVER OBSTACLES. RIDERS MAY NOT CROSS ENTER INTO ANY OTHER DIVISION WHERE LOPE/CANTER IS REQUIRED.

RANCH HORSE DEFINITIONS

RANCH RIDING FLAT: REFLECTS THE VERSATILITY, ATTITUDE AND MOVEMENT OF A WORKING HORSE. THE HORSE'S PERFORMANCE SHOULD SIMULATE A HORSE RIDING OUTSIDE THE CONFINES OF AN ARENA AND THAT OF A WORKING RANCH HORSE. THIS CLASS SHOULD SHOW THE HORSE'S ABILITY TO WORK AT A FORWARD SPEED WHILE UNDER THE RIDER'S CONTROL. THIS CLASS WILL BE JUDGED AT THE WALK, TROT AND LOPE ON THE RAIL.

RANCH RIDING: REFLECTS THE VERSATILITY, ATTITUDE AND MOVEMENT OF A WORKING HORSE. THE HORSE'S PERFORMANCE SHOULD SIMULATE A HORSE RIDING OUTSIDE THE CON NES OF AN ARENA AND THAT OF A WORKING RANCH HORSE. THIS CLASS SHOULD SHOW THE HORSE'S ABILITY TO WORK AT A FORWARD SPEED WHILE UNDER THE RIDER'S CONTROL. THIS IS A PATTERN CLASS.

RANCH HORSE TRAIL: THIS CLASS WILL WORK A MINIMUM OF SIX OBSTACLES DESIGNED TO SHOW A HORSES ABILITY AND WILLINGNESS TO PERFORM A NORMAL DAYS RANCH WORK. WILL INCLUDE A WALK, TROT AND LOPE AS PART OF THE TRAIL COURSE.

RANCH REINING - THE RANCH REINING CLASS MEASURES THE ABILITY OF THE RANCH HORSE TO PERFORM BASIC HANDLING MANEUVERS WITH A NATURAL HEAD CARRIAGE IN A FORWARD looking manner. Patterns may be chosen from any of the RANCH REINING PATTERNS OR APPROVED BY THE SHOW management and judge. To rein a horse is not only to GUIDE HIM BUT ALSO TO CONTROL HIS EVERY MOVEMENT. THE BEST REINED HORSE SHOULD BE WILLINGLY GUIDED OR CONTROLLED WITH LITTLE OR NO APPARENT RESISTANCE AND DICTATED TO COMPLETELY. ANY MOVEMENT ON HIS OWN MUST BE CONSIDERED A LACK OF CONTROL. ALL DEVIATIONS FROM THE EXACT WRITTEN PATTERN MUST BE CONSIDERED A LACK OF OR TEMPORARY LOSS OF CONTROL AND THEREFORE A FAULT THAT MUST BE MARKED DOWN ACCORDING TO SEVERITY OF DEVIATION THE HORSE/RIDER TEAM'S OVERALL PERFORMANCE SHOULD BE CREDITED FOR SMOOTHNESS, FINESSE, ATTITUDE, OUICKNESS AND AUTHORITY OF PERFORMING VARIOUS MANEUVERS WHILE USING CONTROLLED SPEED WHICH RAISES THE DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY AND MAKES THE HORSE/RIDER TEAM MORE EXCITING A PLEASING to watch. For more rules and details see the VHR Ranch Reining rules beginning on pg. 219 in the AQHA HANDBOOK.
