\$5,000 ATKINSON RANCH HAUNTED HUNTER DERBY

Class 450. Entry Fee \$150. Fences 3'

Must have entered two other classes at this show to be eligible.

All entries work in first round – Top 10 return for a handy round. 2 option fences in Handy Round set at 3'3. Earn 1 bonus point per option fence completed successfully. Special award to high scoring JR and Amateur. Prize money: 1st - 30%; 2nd - 22%; 3rd; 13%; 4th - 8%; 5th - 6%; 6th - 5%; 7th - 4%; 8th - 3%; 9th - 3%; 10th - 2%.

46TH ALMADEN FARMS MEDAL FINALS

Class 170. Entry Fee \$100.

Open to any Jr/Am rider who has won a ribbon in a qualifying class from October 2022 to October 2023. Finals will be a two round competition at 2'9 with increasingly difficult tests included in the course. The order of go will be drawn for both rounds. Scores from the 2 rounds will be added together. After the second round, the top 10 riders will return for a work-off devised by the judges. A score from the work-off will be added to the score riders return with. Any further work-off will be at the judges discretion. Ribbons will be awarded to 10th place. The Champion will win a golf cart, Res. Champion a \$1,000 gift certificate to Tack Warehouse, 3rd place a \$500 gift certificate to Tack Warehouse, prizes for 4th-10th place.

MARY BELL PONY HORSEMANSHIP CHALLENGE

Class 514. Entry Fee \$50.

Any ties will be broken by additional tests devised by the judge(s). Scores will be posted when competition is completed. Phase I: Written test, pick up with show number, return to show office by Saturday noon. Phase II: Flat work as a group. Phase III: Gymnastics. Phase IV: Over fences 2'0 Sm/Med, 2'6 Large. Course will be set on a 12-foot stride. Prizes: \$500 gift certificate for Tack Warehouse to champion, \$250 gift certificate to res. champion. Prizes to all top 10 with certificates for free stalls for 2024 shows.

LEGACY FARMS 2'3 EQUITATION FOR A JUMP

Classes 606, 607. Entry Fee \$100. Fences 2'3

Open to all non-pro riders not showing over 2'9 at this show. Scores from both rounds added together. Brand new Jump goes home with the winner.

HUNTERVILLE 3' EQUITATION FOR A JUMP

Classes 611, 612. Entry Fee \$100. Fences 3'0

Scores from both rounds added together to determine winner. Brand new, Jump goes home with the winner.

Open to non-pro riders only.

\$3,000 RANDOLPH FAMILY 2' HUNTER DERBY

Class 615. Entry Fee \$150. Fences 2'0.

Open only to riders not showing over 2'6 at this show and who have NOT shown at 3'0 or higher in the last 2 years. The first round will be a derby type hunter course set at 2'0.

The top 13 after the first round will return for the second round. Entries must have been entered and shown in at least one class at this show not over 2'6 (jumpers included), large ponies ok. Champion through 12th will receive, in addition to their prize money, \$200 gift certificates to Tack Warehouse compliments of the Randolph family and a very special award will go to the rider finishing in 13th place. Scores from 2nd round and total only will be announced. Prize money 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 13%, 4th 8%, 5th 6%, 6th 5%, 7th 4%, 8th 3%, 9th 3%, 10th 2%, 11th 2%, 12th 2%.

CAROLYN DAY HORSEMANSHIP

600-601-602. Entry Fee \$75

Open to Juniors and Amateurs – 4 phase competition. Same horse to be used for all 3 riding phases. One or more judges to officiate. Scores from all 4 phases will be added together, highest total wins. No scores made public until completion of the competition. Previous winners of the over-all competition – previously Sonoma Saddlelery Horsemanship – no longer eligible for this competition. Phase I: Written test. Pick up test with entry number, turn in by Saturday noon. Phase II: Flat work as a group. Phase III: Gymnastics at 2'0. Saturday morning, first class – Stable Mix Arena. Phase IV: Over fences 2'6. After the final phase, all riders within 6 points of the leader (but no less than 6 riders) will perform a work-off devised by the judges. Champion wins a golf cart, Res. Champion a \$1,000 gift certificate to Tack Warehouse, 3rd place a \$500 gift certificate to Tack Warehouse. Prizes for all from 4th through 10th place.

WEST COAST EQUITATION CHALLENGE

Class 608/609. Entry Fee \$100.

Open only to riders who have not shown over 2'9 during this current show year. Class will consist of two rounds and then a work-off of 10 of the top scoring riders after two rounds. Scores will not be announced but may be seen after the competition is complete. Champion wins a golf cart. Reserve Champion receives a \$1,000 shopping spree at the Tack Warehouse. 3rd place \$500 shopping spree at Tack Warehouse. *Shopping spree may not be exchanged for cash. Awards will be given to 10th place.

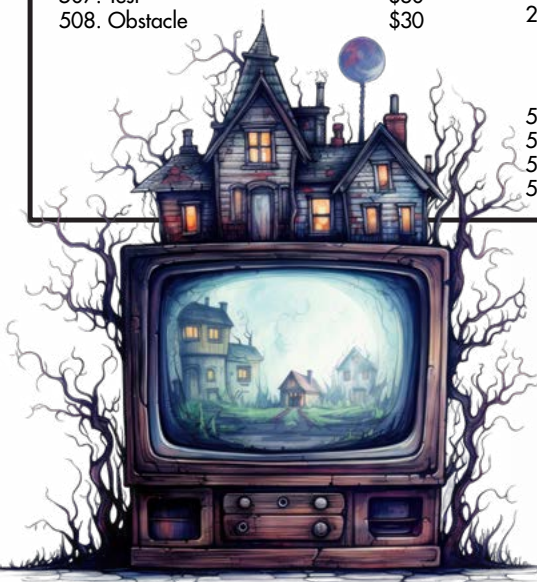

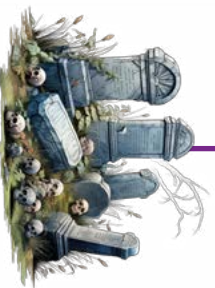

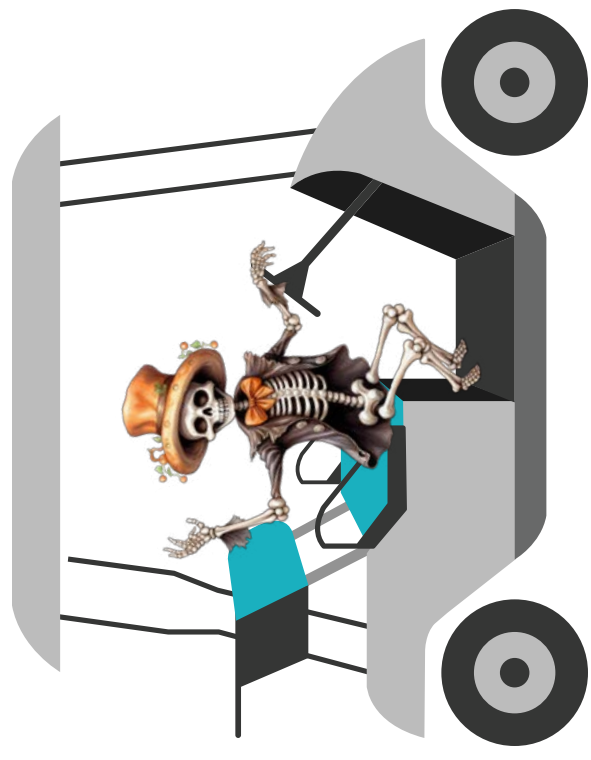

Medal Specifications

ALMADEN JUNIOR & SENIOR: Open to Junior and Amateur riders. The class may be held over hunter or jumper type fences at 2'9 in height. Three riders must enter for the class to count. Any rider showing in classes with fences over 3'3 in height at the same show may not show in this medal. The course must include a combination, two changes of direction and two tests built into the course, i.e: trot, halt, back, etc. Additional testing is at the judges discretion. All ribbon winners in qualifying classes qualify for the finals.

CPHA FOUNDATION EQUITATION: Open to Junior and Amateur riders who are current members of the CPHA and PCHA. Judged over an equitation type course of at least 8 fences 3'3 in height with at least 2 USEF tests (1, 2, 6, 10, 12, 15,17, 18) included in the course. Three riders must compete and complete the course in order for the class to count as a qualifier.

CPHA JR/SR MEDAL: Five must compete, three must complete the course. Trainer and Rider must be CPHA members. Fences 3'6, same course as a USEF Jr. Medal. Top 3 riders test after the first round.

THE CLOVERLEAF EQUITATION CLASSIC: Class is open to Junior & Amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'7 in height. To be judged over a Jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance & control of the horse on a Jumper type of ride. There will not be a time allowed; a tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any Jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties will be considered in accordance with USEF Equitation rules. Additional work-offs after the initial round will be at the Judge's discretion, and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter & show in the class. All ribbons winners in qualifying classes are qualified for the finals. Winner of the finals will receive a golf cart & a cooler, prizes to 8th place.

HORSE & HOUND JR/AM MEDAL: Open to riders that have not won a 3'6 or higher medal finals in the last 3 years and are not showing 3'6 or higher at this show. Hunter or jumper type course at 3'0 with 2 tests included in the course. 5 points qualified for the finals. Previous winners of the Horse & Hound medal finals are no longer eligible.

HORSE & HOUND PONY MEDAL: To be shown over a course of fences (Sm/Med to jump 2'3, Lg to jump 2'6) with 2 tests included. Riders may not show 3'6 or higher at this show. Previous winners of the medal finals are no longer eligible to compete. Points and qualifying same as the Horse & Hound Jr/Am Medal. A sterling silver pendant will be given to the winner of a qualifying class with 5 or more entries.

JRW JUNIOR/AMATEUR: To be shown over a course of Hunter/Jumper type fences approx. 3'3, with flat work incorporated into the course. NO work-off is required, but further testing is at the judge's discretion. Points awarded to the top 8 riders (8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1) points will be doubled in classes with 15 or more. Six points required to qualify a rider for Finals. Five riders must complete the course.

PCHA HORSEMANSHIP 14/U, 18-34, 35/O:

This class is designed as an intermediate equitation class for riders 14 years of age and under who are current PCHA members. A rider who will not be 14 years old (horse show age) or under on the date of the Finals may not compete in the class. To be held over a course of at least eight (8) fences about 3'3 in height. Hunter-type fences are encouraged. One combination must be included and at least two changes of direction with two tests included as part of the original course. No workoff is required; but further testing is at the judges discretion. To fill a class, three competitors must complete the course. Riders may qualify by achieving the necessary 12 points or by winning a class of five or more entries. Qualified riders will receive a medal. Regardless of how many points he/she accumulates, a rider can continue to compete in qualifying classes until he/she has won a class of five or more entries.

ONONDARCA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL: For riders 12 years of age and under, current members of the PCHA, Three must complete over a 3'0 course, additional testing of top 4 required.

SAHJA PONY MEDAL: Open to Junior riders showing ponies (14.2 hands and under). To be judged over a course of fences ranging from 2'0 to 2'6 in height, with two USEF tests (1-9) incorporated in the course. There is no work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

SAHJA MINI MEDAL: Open to any Junior or Amateur rider who has not won a rated 3'6 medal class or any medal finals, except the SAHJA Pony Medal. Riders to be judged over a course of fences 2'6 in height, with at least two USEF tests (1-19) incorporated into the course. There is no work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

SAHJA CHILD/ADULT MEDAL: Open to any Junior or Amateur rider. Riders to be judged over a course of fences 3'0 in height. At least the top four will return for a flat work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

CPHA CHILD/ADULT: Trainers and riders must be CPHA members. 3'0 course, minimum of 2 riders work-off. 3 must compete for class to count.

CPHA HORSEMANSHIP: Child/Adult riders may not have won any class 3' or higher in the last 10 years. Fences 2'6, no combinations, test in course. 2 must compete.

THE MADDEN CROSS RAIL MEDAL: Riders in this medal may not be showing over 1'3 at this show. Open only to Jr/Am riders. Trotting & cantering allowed. To be judged on a rider's equitation over a course of not less than 8 fences with at least two additional equitation tests included in the course. All riders earning a ribbon in this class are qualified for the finals. Qualifying period from October 2022 to October 2023. Finals will be held at the Brookside Fall Finale in 2023 & the winner will earn a golf cart.

Rules & General Information

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Care should be taken to enter each horse in it's proper division or class. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in completing entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted. Stipulations for entry blank: 1. Be properly signed and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian. 2. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show. 3. Show the correct mailing address of the owner. 4. Social Security number must be on the entry blank. 5. Include PCHA membership numbers. 6. Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of jr. and amateur riders. 7. For each horse entered send a \$350 stall fee and \$50 schooling and registration fee. Send with your completed entry blank on or before the closing date. If entries are post-marked not later than the closing date and are properly filled out no late fee will be charged. **ONLY CASH AND CHECKS ACCEPTED.**

POST ENTRIES: Accepted at management's discretion. Pay a \$5 post entry fee for each class added or changed (see also Illegal Entry Penalty). Adds and scratches are allowed at the gate, but must be completed in the office by 4pm daily to avoid being charged. **ON SUNDAY, NO ADD/SCRATCHES ALLOWED AT THE GATE.**

CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered in competition will be under control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be the condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its directors and employees, and Murieta Equestrian Center harmless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. All owners and exhibitors will be held accountable for any damage incurred by them, their agents, or employees, to the stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.

MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or guardian.

REFUNDS: Before the closing date of entries, full refunds will be given. After the closing date, with veterinarian or doctors certificate, refunds will be given less a \$50 office charge, and less fees held prior to notification at the Horse Show Office, whether exhibited in or not. Stall fees may be refunded if canceled by October 9, 2023.

PRIZES: Awards to 1st place in all classes, ribbons 1st-8th. Prize money will be made payable to the owner listed on the entry blank (unless other arrangements are made with the Horse Show Office) and mailed within 30 days.

NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID UNLESS OWNERS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. In all classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show. Horses entered but not showing will forfeit their add-back money to Management unless they scratch before the class. All money classes under \$500 will be divided 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%. All \$500 prize money classes will be paid: \$150, \$100, \$75, \$65, \$60, \$50. All \$1,000 and over prize money classes will be paid: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5% unless otherwise noted.

MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions & conditions in regard to or arising out of or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management reserves the right to limit entries at its discretion.

TRANSFERS: The transfer of a horse and/or riders from one class/division to another will be allowed as follows:

a) Credit will be given for scratched classes, but post entries must be paid for all added;

STABLING: Stalls and tack rooms will be available for \$350 each. No bedding included. Stalls are of portable construction, 10' x 10' with top and bottom doors with dirt floors. Stalls will not be available prior to 8AM, Monday, October 23 unless specific arrangements are made with show management or call MEC at 916-985-7334

FEED & BEDDING: Must be ordered directly from the form included in this book and sent to MEC prior to the show.

GROUND'S FEE: All horses entering the show and not using a stall will pay a \$75 per day grounds fee, used to offset facility cost, clean up, and amenities.

RV PARKING: Make reservations on the MEC website.

COURSES: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: brush, gate, oxers, panels, post & rails, coops & walls.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled as follows: ALL RETURNED CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL 10% PENALTY (\$25 MINIMUM), accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with cash or money order, or they will be turned in to the sanctioning organizations for further disciplinary action.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: For any horse on the grounds and not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a "Not to Show" form, sign a release at the Horse Show Office, and pay a \$50 schooling/registration fee.

SCHOOLING FEE: Schooling will be allowed in all arenas on Tuesday at approximately 1pm and at the end of each show day with time permitting. NO SCHOOLING IN ARENAS AFTER COURSES HAVE BEEN SET FOR THE FOLLOWING DAY. Mandatory schooling/registration fee for all horses: \$50.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles if accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for action against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include the exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against above individuals in. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ARENAS AND FOOTING: All arenas and warm-up rings are GGT footing. Hunter Ring 1 measures 120'x250'; Hunter Ring 2 measures 230'x115'; Ring 3 measures 120' x 240'; Jumper Ring 1 is 280'x140'; and Jumper Ring 2 is 180'x216'.
